LOCAL LAW NO. 4-1956 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law Amending Section 5 of Chapter 780 of the Laws of 1950, Local Law No. 1 of the Year 1952 of the County of Chautauqua, and Local Law No. 1 of the Year 1956 of the County of Chautauqua, Relating to the Licensing of Boats and the Attaching Thereto of a Yearly Number Plate

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

Section 1. Section 2b and Local Law No. 1 of the year 1956 of the County of Chautauqua is hereby amending to read as follows:

Section 2-b. Every boat licensed under this act shall have attached in a conspicuous place to the <u>port side</u> or stern thereof a yearly number plate to be provided by the Commissioner. Such number plate shall be displayed as all ties during the current year that said boat is licensed. In the event that a number plate becomes lost or destroyed a new license and number plate for the boat for which such license was issued shall be re-issued for the sum of fifty cents (50c).

Section 2. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
