

LOCAL LAW NO. 3-1976
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law to Amend Article VIII, Section 8.08 of the Chautauqua Administrative Code in relation to the Composition of the Chautauqua County Mental Health Board

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

SECTION 1. That Article VIII, Section 8.08 of the Chautauqua Administrative Code be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 8.08 *Chautauqua Mental Health Board*

There shall be an advisory mental health board composed of "at least nine (9) and not more than fifteen (15)" members appointed by the County Executive for a four (4) year term and approved by the Legislature. Its purpose shall be to review and evaluate community mental health services and facilities, recommended policies and procedure to the Division(s) of Mental Health and other Mental Health Agencies and to perform such other acts appropriate to improving the effectiveness of (the) mental health services in the County.

SECTION 2. This Local Law, subject to a permissive referendum, shall take effect forty-five (45) days after adoption.
