

LOCAL LAW NO. 5-1977  
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law to Amend Article XV of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code in Relation to Approval of Contracts

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

SECTION 1. That Article XV, Section 15.02, of the Chautauqua Administrative Code be, and the same is hereby, amended to read as follows:

"Section 15.02 *Approval of Contracts*

Except as otherwise provided in the Charter or Code, every contract to which the County is a party shall require approval by the Legislature, if said contract is for (a) the sale or purchase of real property; (b) the erection, alteration or demolition of a building or other structure; (c) the providing of facilities or the rendering of services by, for or with any other public corporation. All such contracts shall be executed by the County Executive. No *such* contract shall be executed by the County Executive until the same has been approved as to form by the County Attorney." Copies of such contract when executed, shall be filed with the Director of Finance, the Comptroller and the Legislature. (when approval of said board is required for such contracts.)

SECTION 2. This Local Law, subject to permissive referendum, shall take effect fifty-five (45) days after adoption.
