LOCAL LAW NO. 2-1978 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law Allowing Release of Funds Liened Under Section 22 of the General Municipal Law

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

- 1. Upon the adoption of a resolution providing that the Chautauqua County Director of Finance shall serve upon the New York State Superintendent of Insurance notice of intention to claim against fire insurance proceeds for delinquent real estate property taxes, as authorized by Section 22 (3) of the General Municipal Law, the County of Chautauqua may nevertheless release or return to the insured any or all amounts to which it would be otherwise entitled to claim, provided that the insured agrees with the County, in writing, to restore the affected premises to the same or improved condition that the subject premises was in prior to the time that the lien of the County of Chautauqua against proceeds provided for by Section 22 of the General Municipal Law arose, subject to such conditions as such resolution shall provide to guarantee performance of such obligation by the insured.
- 2. This Local Law shall become effective on the date on which it is filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.
