

LOCAL LAW NO. 5-90
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING A UNIFORM PROPERTY NUMBERING SYSTEM IN
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

SECTION 1. Short Title

This law shall be known as the "Uniform Property Numbering Law."

SECTION 2. Purpose.

With the pending implementation of the Enhanced 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone System, a Uniform Property Numbering system must be implemented. By the Emergency Resolution 49-59, Adopted March 13, 1959, the Chautauqua County Board of Supervisors adopted an "Approved Property Number System" which was recommended to the various potential subdivisions.

This local law shall require the use of the system established in March, 1959, within the Enhanced 9-1-1 Service Area of Chautauqua County.

SECTION 3. Uniform Numbering

a) EAST-WEST ROADS: Numbers for property on east-west roads shall start with 0 at the eastern border of the County and progress westerly with 1800 numbers assigned to each six (6) mile section, measured in a straight line, and not actual mileage measured on the road. Even numbers shall be assigned to north side property. Odd numbers shall be assigned to the south side property.

b) NORTH-SOUTH ROADS: Numbers for property on north-south roads shall start with 0 at the southern border of the County and progress north-south with 2000 numbers assigned to each six (6) mile section measured in a straight line and not actual mileage measured on the road. Even numbers shall be assigned to east side property. Odd numbers shall be assigned to west side property.

SECTION 4. Map

That the map attached to this local law showing the streets, highways and roads in Chautauqua County and the various numbers in increments as described in Section 3 above, is hereby part of this local law and is hereby established as the Uniform Property Number Map of the County of Chautauqua.

SECTION 5. Number Display

a) This Uniform Property Numbering System is established for purpose of development of the County's Enhanced 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone System. To improve the system efficiently, property owners are encouraged to post the right hand corner of the door frame or near a lighted area on the front of their house visible from the road.

b) Property owners are encouraged to use numbers which are at least four (4) inches in size reflectorized.

SECTION 6. Implementation.

The Sheriff and County Fire Coordinator are authorized to take whatever action is necessary to implement their numbering system and are specifically authorized to deal directly with the United States Postal System and Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation to implement the number system.

SECTION 7. Filing.

Copies of this local law shall be filed with the Clerk of Chautauqua County and the clerk of each municipality in Chautauqua County.

SECTION 8. Separability.

If any provision of this local law, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held invalid, the remainder of this local law, and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 9. Effective Date.

This Local Law shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.
