

LOCAL LAW NO. 8-91  
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

AMENDING CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY CODE – RE BUDGET PROCESS

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York as follows:

Section 1. The seventh paragraph of Section 15.07 of Article 15 of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code is hereby amended as follows:

Upon adoption of the Budget, the Legislature shall adopt resolutions appropriation the money therefore and authorizing the levy of taxes. In the event the Legislature fails to finally adopt a budget for the ensuing fiscal year on or before December first, the tentative budget shall constitute the budget for the ensuing fiscal year. The appropriation resolution and the resolution authorizing the levy of taxes shall be deemed to have been passed by the Legislature as of such date.

Section 2. All other provisions of Section 15.07 of Article 15 of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Section 19 of Local Law 2-91 is hereby amended to provide that Local Law 2-91 shall be effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law or upon approval of this Local Law by majority of the qualified electors in the event a permissive referendum is held.

Section 4. This Local Law shall become effective forty-five (45) days after adoption, or upon approval by a majority of the qualified electors in the event a permissive referendum is held in accordance with Municipal Home Rule Law.
