

LOCAL LAW NO. 5-93  
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY CHARTER

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1.03 of Article 1 of the Chautauqua County Charter is hereby amended to substitute the work "inconsistency" for the word "consistency" as it appears in said Section.

SECTION 2. Section 3.02 (h) of Article III of the Chautauqua County Charter is hereby amended to read as follows:

(h) Make, sign, execute, and implement all contracts on behalf of the County, within the amounts authorized by the County Legislature, except that a contract for: 1) the sale, purchase or transfer of real property, 2) the erection, alteration or demolition of a building or other structure, or 3) the provision of facilities [of] or the rendering of services by or for any other government must be approved by the County Legislature.

SECTION 3. This Local Law shall become effective forty-five days after adoption, or upon approval by a majority of the qualified electors in the event a permissive referendum is held in accordance with Municipal Home Rule Law.
