

LOCAL LAW NO. 7-99
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW AUTHORIZING CERTAIN WATER, SEWER AND DRAINAGE
IMPROVEMENTS IN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF CHAUTAUQUA

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

Section 1. Purpose.

The purpose of this local law is to enable the County of Chautauqua to authorize, undertake and/or fund water, sewer and drainage improvements in said County in order to preserve the County's environment, to enhance the County's infrastructure for future economic development, and to protect the health, safety and welfare of County residents and property, it being hereby determined that the authorization set forth in this local law shall be in addition to the powers conferred upon the County of Chautauqua by Article 5-A of the County Law or any other applicable law.

Section 2. Authorization.

The County of Chautauqua is hereby authorized to adopt one or more bond resolutions pursuant to the Local Finance Law authorizing the issuance of obligations to effect the intent and purposes of this local law and, in connection therewith, accept, appropriate and expend any monies legally made available to said County to pay all or a part of the costs of any such improvements.

Section 3. Severability.

In the event any provisions or part of this local law shall for any reason be adjudged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of the local law.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect immediately.
