LOCAL LAW NO. 4-01 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW 7-90 PROVIDING FOR A MANAGEMENT SALARY PLAN FOR COUNTY OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES RE. OFFICERS APPOINTED FOR A FIXED TERM

BE IT ENACTED, by the Legislature of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

Section 1. 2001, 2002, and 2003 Adjustment of Salary Ranges for Officers Appointed For a Fixed Term

On the effective date of this Local Law, the maximum level of management salary ranges for officers appointed for a fixed term established pursuant to Local Law 7-90, as amended, shall be increased by 3.5%, except for positions with designated flat salaries. Effective January 2002, the maximum level of management salary ranges for officers appointed for a fixed term established pursuant to Local Law 7-90, as amended, shall be further increased by 4%, except for positions with designated flat salaries. Section 2. Effective Date.

This Local Law shall become effective forty-five (45) days after adoption or upon approval by the majority of the qualified electors in the event a permissive referendum is held in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law.
