LOCAL LAW . NO. 4-05 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

AMENDING LOCAL LAW 7-90 PROVIDING FOR A MANAGEMENT SALARY PLAN FOR COUNTY OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES

BE IT ENACTED, by the Chautauqua County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York, as follows:

Section 1. 2005, 2006 and 2007 Adjustment of Salary Ranges for Officers Appointed for a Fixed Term.

On the effective date of this Local Law, the management salary ranges for officers appointed for a fixed term established pursuant to Local Law 7-90, as amended, shall be adjusted to reflect an increase of 3.25%, except for positions with designated flat salaries. Effective January 1, 2006, the management salary ranges for officers appointed for a fixed term established pursuant to Local Law 7-90, as amended, shall be further adjusted to reflect an increase of 3%, except for positions with designated flat salaries. Effective January 1, 2007, the management salary ranges for officers appointed for a fixed term established pursuant to Local Law 7-90, as amended, shall be further adjusted to reflect an increase of 3%, except for positions with designated flat salaries. The maximum level of the salary range shall be a cap on the amount which may be paid for a full year of service.

Section 2. Effective Date.

This local law shall become effective forty-five (45) days after adoption, or upon approval by a majority of the qualified electors in the event a permissive referendum is held in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law.
