

LOCAL LAW NO. 5-06
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY CHARTER
REGARDING LEGISLATIVE CONFIRMATION
OF SPECIAL ASSISTANT FOR MEDICAID

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York,
as follows:

Section I. Amendment to County Charter.

Section 3.02(c) of the Chautauqua County Charter governing the County Executive's
authority to prescribe the staffing of executive branch entities is hereby amended as follows:

(c) Exercise supervision and control of all executive branch entities, and
shall prescribe, within budget appropriations, the staffing, internal organization
and reorganization of such entities, including appointment of any heads of such
entities, provided, however, that the appointment of the chief fiscal officer of the
County and the Special Assistant for Medicaid shall be subject to confirmation
by the County Legislature. In this connection, the Executive shall have the
power to determine who shall perform such duties and have such powers not
otherwise clearly defined by the Charter.

Section II. Effective Date.

This Local Law shall take effect sixty (60) days after adoption, or upon approval by a
majority of the qualified electors in the event a permissive referendum is held in accordance
with Municipal Home Rule Law.
