

LOCAL LAW NO. 1-08  
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW ABOLISHING THE PETTY CASH ACCOUNT FOR DISTRICT  
ATTORNEY

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York,  
as follows:

1. Purpose. The purpose of this Local Law is to abolish a petty cash fund created in 1972, which is no longer necessary for the efficient operation of the District Attorney's Office.
2. Account Abolished. The petty cash account created by Local Law 4-1972 (Intro No. 5-1972) known as the "Petty Cash Prosecution Fund" is hereby abolished.
3. Effective Date. This Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
