LOCAL LAW NO. 1-08 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW ABOLISHING THE PETTY CASH ACCOUNT FOR DISTRICT ATTORNEY

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York, as follows:

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this Local Law is to abolish a petty cash fund created in 1972, which is no longer necessary for the efficient operation of the District Attorney's Office.
- 2. <u>Account Abolished</u>. The petty cash account created by Local Law 4-1972 (Intro No. 5-1972) known as the "Petty Cash Prosecution Fund" is hereby abolished.
- 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
