

LOCAL LAW NO. 2-09
CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A LOCAL LAW ABOLISHING TERM LIMITS FOR THE COMMUNITY SERVICES
BOARD OF CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York,
as follows:

1. Purpose. To promote mental health services in Chautauqua County and improve efficiencies in the Community Services Board by allowing experienced members to serve more than two terms.
2. Abolish Term Limits. The provision in Section 41.11(d) of the Mental Hygiene Law limiting members of the Community Services Board of Chautauqua County to no more than two (2) consecutive terms is hereby superseded by this Local Law and term limits for the Community Services Board of Chautauqua County are hereby abolished.
3. Effective Date. This Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
