

Selected Antislavery Statements by Chautauqua County Baptists and some of their Neighboring Baptists: Excerpts from Annual Meetings 1838 through 1862.

**1842:** At the Fourth Session of the Harmony Baptist Association held in the Baptist Meeting House of the Clymer Church, August 30<sup>th</sup>, 31<sup>st</sup>, and September 1<sup>st</sup>, **1842**, according to the minutes printed by A. **Fletcher**, Jamestown, 1842, the Baptists made the following statement: **“Resolved, That we look upon Slavery as it exists at the South as a great moral evil, and do most affectionately beseech our brethren, to put away this sin for their own good and the good of the oppressed.”**

**1847:** At the Ninth Annual Session of the Harmony Baptist Association, held with the Harmony Baptist Church in Panama, Chautauque, N.Y., August 24<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, and 26<sup>th</sup>, 1847, Mayville, N.Y., according to the minutes printed by John F. **Phelps**. 1847, the Baptists made the following statement: “**Resolved, That we bear unequivocal and decided testimony against the use of Alcoholic drinks -- American Slavery – and Secret, Oath bound Societies of all names; and recommend that the Churches keep themselves clear in these matters.**” Additionally, the Westfield delegation wrote that “**they hate Slavery and all other institutions of the Devil.**”

**1848** : At the First Anniversary of the Erie Baptist Association (in Cattaraugus & Chautauque Counties, N.Y.) held in the Baptist Meeting House, in the Village of Forestville, Chautauque County, N. Y., September 5, 6, 7, 1848, according to the minutes printed at the *Censor* office, Fredonia, N.Y., 1848, the Baptists made the following statement: “**On motion of Br. D. Morse, it was Resolved, That we deeply deplore the connexion of any portion of the Christian World, and**

especially the Baptist denomination, with the sin of Slavery; and we recommend to the Ministers and Churches composing this body, that by every instrumentality which the Gospel furnishes wherewith to combat sin, they labor for its extinction.”

**1847-1848**: At the Tenth Annual Session of the Harmony Baptist Association. Held with the Baptist Church in Frewsburg, Chautauque Co., N. Y., August 29<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup>, and 31<sup>st</sup>, 1848, according to the minutes printed by F. W. **Palmer** & Co., Jamestown, the Baptists made the following statement: “**Resolved, that we bear unequivocal and decided testimony against the use of alcoholic drinks and against American slavery.**” Also printed were specific anti-slavery

statements made by individual churches in Busti, Jamestown, and North Harmony, after which the secretary wrote, “**Many of the Churches ... besides those noticed above express their abhorrence of secret societies, of slavery, and of all popular sins, but the detail is omitted, to prevent repetition.**”

**1849:** At the Second Session of the Erie Baptist Association held in the Baptist Meeting House in the Town of Stockton, Chautauque County, N.Y., September 4, 5, & 6, 1849, according to the minutes printed at the *Censor* office, Fredonia, N.Y., 1849, the Baptists made the following statement: “**Resolved, That we deeply deplore the connection of any portion of the christian world, and especially the Baptist denomination with the sin of Slavery, and we recommend to ministers and churches composing this body, that by every instrumentality which the gospel furnishes wherewith to combat sin, they labor for its extinction.... Let the tears, the groans and sufferings of the oppressed Africans speak....**”

**1861**: At the Fourteenth Anniversary of the Erie Baptist Association held with the First Hanover Baptist Church at Nashville, Chautauqua County, N.Y., Sept. 3d, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>, 1861, according to the minutes printed by **Sacket & Bishop**, *Journal Book and Job Office*, Jamestown, N.Y., 1861, the Baptists made the following statement: “Whereas, Our Country is now in the midst of a most distressing civil war, during which, the entire public mind is strained to its utmost tension of anxious suspense – and whereas, in this great struggle, it believed by many that God is at work, and that religious interests, vital and priceless, will be settled on firmer foundations – it seems fitting, that as a body of Christians, we express our decided convictions; and place them on enduring record. Therefore, be it Resolved, That the Erie Baptist Association unite its sympathies and efforts for the preservation of the Federal Government and the crushing out of rebellion. Resolved, that we regard Slavery as the originating, substantial cause of this rebellion, and its removal the only cure – for which our prayers shall be offered, and to which all our energies should be directed, until the cause is effectually removed. Resolved, That we trust and rejoice in God as the God of Zion and all nations, and that we see in these troubles, the steady march of justice, claiming and procuring its rights; that we see the shaking down of slavery from its pedestal of power; that we see with exulting hope, the prophecy and pledge of that time, when God will establish righteousness in all the earth. Resolved, That in view of our present afflicting calamities, we recommend to all our Churches, the observance of Thursday the 26<sup>th</sup> inst, the day named by our Honored National Executive – as a day of Humiliation, fasting and prayer.”
