....Some new monuments have recently been erected....The Goff monument, a massive structure of Italian marble erected in Florence, Italy, but very much improved by the skillful work of our townsman, David Scott. Also the Willey monument and another erected to the memory of two brothers who perished in the late war defending their country. To us, they were strangers, but the attractions of our beautiful cemetery induced their friends to deposit the remains of their loved ones in a spot which would always be cared for, and there erect a monument to their memory.....24 July 1868: An Ungenerous Claim....The *Fredonia Censor* speaks of FHC as "our beautiful burial place" as though it were an enterprise exclusively their own, notwithstanding ³/₄ of the lots and seven eighths of the adornments of that cemetery belong to Dunkirkers who are unwilling to give credit for the attractions of that cherished spot to others. They feel about it just as Fredonians would should the *Journal* invite attention to our highly finished stone-work in the Normal School building simpley because our citizen, David Scott, was employed to precepare and put up the inscription stone, which job was given to hime because their own mechanics bungled so badly on the corner stone.
