Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 34 of the New York State Election Law, we submit the following Annual Report for the calendar year of 1970.

This has been an unusually active gubernatorial election year. It was characterized by a three party primary in the 149th Assembly District and a two party primary in the 150th Assembly District which were held on June 23rd, 1970 from noon to 9:00 P.M.

This office was placed in the position of applying its' ministerial duties as prescribed by the Election Law in invalidating several nominating petitions for party positions for this primary.

The number of enrolled voters who were eligible and who participated by Party are as follows:

This necessitated the opening of all 125 election districts. Due to the unusual and complicated nature of the three party primary in the 149th A.D., this office conducted a Primary Election School of Instructions for the Inspectors of Election in Dunkirk, New York. The Primary winners were then placed on the ballot for the fall November General Election.

The final decision of the Court of Appeals for the November General Election was reached on October 7, 1970. Until this time it was questionable if the voting machines had sufficient capacity to accomodate all of the political and independent parties.

The Court of Appeals decision left these parties on the ballot: Republican, Democratic, Conservative, Liberal, Civil Service Independents, Socialist Worker, Communist, Socialist Labor and the Independent Alliance.

The results of Proposition Number One ("An act to amend the Public Housing Law") which was on the ballot State-wide are:

The 1970 Ballot was further complicated by two local propositions in the City of Jamestown. Proposition Number Two dealt with extending the terms of Mayor and Councilmen from two to four years. Proposition Number Three dealt with permitting the playing of Bingo.

There were no A.B.C. questions this year which are conducted under the Election Law ss 243 and A.B.C. Law ss 141.

The day following the November 3rd Election, this office received the Election supplies which were returned from all of the 125 Election Districts, the bulk before noon. These districts utilized 153 voting machines. This is four less than the previous year due to the Sewer District Question which split Election Districts geographically. This mandated extra machines in those districts which permitted those eligible to vote on the Sewer Question.

Bi-partisan teams, consisting of permanent employees began the canvass of the 153 voting machines that very afternoon. This requires a personal inspection of the sealed voting machines and verification of the results as recorded by the Election Inspectors. This physical inspection was completed by Friday at 5:00 p.m. At this time the temporary help is needed annually to process the voluminous statistics in order that this office may certify the results within the mandated time.

Due to the time schedules mandated by the New York State Election Law, unusually heavy demands have been made on the County Printing Department by this office. For example, Section 376 of the Election Law mandates the printing of Registration Lists for each of the 125 Election Districts of the newly registered voters of October 3rd and 6th.

Furthermore, the Election Law stipulates that a qualified person could move, up to and including Friday, October 23rd, thus changing his address and possibly the Election District. Thus accurate registration lists have to be printed after this date. Our office is mandated per Section 376, sub. 4, for the distribution of lists, not less than six days prior to the day of Election, Wednesday, October 28th. Sub-division 5 of this section compels distribution of Registration Lists before the 6th day also to the Secretary of State and the Attorney General.

The Printer will receive in late January, data relative to the more than 65,000 registered voters for the completion of printed Enrollments (before the first of March, 1971 pursuant to Election Law, ss 377). Our efforts to process this data is impeded by Election Law, ss 186 which states that we cannot open the Enrollments until the Tuesday following the General Election and must be completed before the succeeding first day of February, the succeeding year. Increased use of temporary employees for ten months of the year is due to the continually expanding normal and peak work load.

Concomitant with Sec. 377, Sec. 405 mandates a Purge List begun in the second week in December and be completed in the third week in the succeeding January. All permanent records and data related to the more than 65,000 enrolled voters have to be individually examined to verify if the registrant has voted at least once in a General Election during the past two years. All those that have not must be notified by mail (6,986 individuals) of the impending cancellation of their status as a registered voter unless they fill out, sign and return the re-instatement request form within four weeks of the date of the postmark on the notification. After this four week interval the list of 65,000 registered and enrolled voters are compiled and sent to the printer, pursuant to section 377 in conjunction with the needs of section 191, sub. 1-a.

At this point, the total number of registered voters is determined by tabulating the following:

At the time of this writing, we estimate our registered voters will increase to approximately 65,000.

Registration records under Section 381 of the Election Law are used for Village and School District Elections. Village Law, Section 4-426 (8a) states "However, if such Village is located in a County wherein permanent personal registration is required, they (Village inspectors of elections) shall copy such names from the registration poll records."

Such registration information is given by this office. In conjunction with this, a Political Calendar pertaining to these March Elections are available for interested individuals in the Villages of the County.

There is considerable discussion by the Joint Legislative Committee to place Village Registration under the supervision of the Board of Elections. Presently all individuals who are registered with the Board of Elections, under P.P.R. are automatically qualified to vote in Village Elections. Conversely, an individual who registers to vote under the Village registration system is not automatically qualified to vote in the General Election. This person must also register again under P.P.R. in order to vote in the General Election thus many Village residents are confused and disenfranchised by this dual system.

At least 8 months (March 3rd) before the General Election, each County, City, Village and Town Clerk, pursuant to Section 314 sub. 3, shall make and transmit to the Board of Elections, a certificate stating each County, City, Village and Town officers respectively, to be voted on at the Election, including any local proposition or question known to such officer at the time of issuance of Certificate. If any officer is to be elected to fill a vacancy, the certificate shall so state. Within the above time period the Secretary of State shall make and transmit to the Board of Elections a Certificate stating each office above County level which lawfully may be voted for at the Election. The concentration of such information in our office, generates many inquiries throughout the year concerning Election Law, Petitions, Primaries and the General Election.

Section 392 of the New York State Election Law provides for a special check of all the registered voters in any or all of the election districts including election districts previously checked. This personal check of registrants is contingent upon the written, filed request of any one member of the Board of Elections and is conducted by legally constituted bi-partisan teams. This is especially important when one recognizes the fact that one family in five moves annually.

In order to conduct such a check, the above mentioned teams must use a registration list, alphabetically by street or road name, and each resident on such street in numerical sequence. Without such a registration list the inspection by this office would be nearly impossible, time consuming and extremely expensive. The lack of this type of list versus alphabetized registration lists by surname was acutely demonstrated in the 1969 Sewer District Election. As a result this office had to create new lists by road name. The only way to eliminate the duplicity of work in such future elections is to maintain lists by Road or Street in alphabetical sequence.

It is the experience of this office that a large number of rural individuals throughout the County do not know the one correct legal name of their road where they legally reside. This office frequently encounters neighbors who give different names for the same road. This senseless problem causes this office untold hours of wasted effort and expense.

Section 394, states the Board of Elections, not less than 15 days nor more than 30 days (September 3rd and 18th) before the first day of Local Registration (October 3rd) shall conduct a mail check of every registered voter. This entails processing 65,000 letters to the 125 Election Districts and notifying the registrant that such communication is a routine check to ascertain whether such voter still resides at this registration address. This September mailing resulted in 3,954 letters listed as undeliverable at the indicated address, plus an additional 1,483 individuals listed as "moved". Within one week (October 13) after the conclusion of Local Registration the Board of Elections shall send similar communication (4,206) letters to every voter registered in such Local Registration. At this point, pursuant to the Election Law, Sec. 331, sub.3, this Board calls upon Law Enforcement Agencies to investigate questionable declared and actual voter residency.

Whenever such communication is returned as undeliverable, the Board of Elections forthwith shall proceed in accordance with the powers granted to it by Section 406 to determine whether such registration of the affected person shall be cancelled. This Board received 3,508 and 3,528 in 1969 and 1968 respectively, letters as undeliverable, and such legal determinations were made and verified in the 20 days prior to Election Day on November 3rd. In addition this office issued 387 Military and 127 Military Dependents Ballots. Absentee Ballots issued were 1018.

The accuracy and efficiency in processing this data is reflected in that no Court Orders were issued. This office does assist in initiating such action as the direct result of any newly acquired information and forwarding it to the issuing Justice.

This office is in reality an office of Vital Statistics of the most current information available on a County wide basis. Each and every month pursuant to Section 397,sub.1, this office receives from the public recording officers of the 15 Villages, 27 Towns and 2 Cities, the deaths in their respective areas in order that we may remove the deceased person from the current registration list.

Central Registration began on January 5, 1970 and this office registered and transferred hundreds of individuals during this period. The continual updating of names and addresses as mandated by the Election Law, of Chautauqua County residents in our office results in many requests for information from the Courts, FBI, Social Security Administration, attorneys, Private Agencies and individuals. This office is one source of names and addresses to the Federal and County Courts for use as potential Jurors. In fact, this office provides many such services for several County Departments.

The November 3, 1970 Gubernatorial Election was differentiated from previous Gubernatorial Elections by the utilizing 100% of the voting machine horizontal line capacity by nine different political parties. This maximum number was derived by the final decision of the Court of Appeals on October 7, 1970 which removed two of the eleven political parties which filed. Thus, 27 days before the November 3rd election this office knew what candidates would be eligible to be placed on the ballot and thus had to transmit such information to the printers.

The non-Presidential Election years present a greater work-load to the Board of Elections than does the Presidential Election. Ironically, an increase in the number of registered non-voters is equated with a larger office work load which is best illustrated as follows:

The increased work load factor develops because every non-voter has to be thus recorded annually on his individual addressograph plate for future purges. The 14,879 non-voters represent more than a two-fold increase over last year and involves a tedious process.

There have been a tremendous number of Court cases throughout Western New York. The Election Law is a very specialized area and requires many hours of research on

various court decisions. Due to the narrow spectrum of the Election Law and the relative infrequency attorneys come in contact with it, many attorneys consult with the Commissioners of Elections for guidance and procedure. This is especially so with the unusually short time period allowed to prepare for court cases.

March 31st was the first day for circulating Designating Petitions. Dates for filing such Designating Petitions were between May 4th and 7th for the June 23rd Primary. As a result of such action there were 10 Primary Election candidates for State - wide office and 26 Primary candidates for local office. This in turn, resulted state wide in 43 candidates running on 9 different political parties seeking election on November 3rd. Even though 1970 is an "off" year for local elections, 11 of the 27 Towns had such an election.

Although this office does not in accordance with Law, have anything to do with the printing of these petitions, we are deluged with questions on proper ways to execute them. Most of these petitions are filed with the Board of Elections. Those persons on whose behalf petitions have been filed are then notified and they can accept or decline the designation. Then it has to be established whether or not a June Primary will occur in each of the offices and if so, prepare for it. The Commissioners of Elections, prior to filing are requested by their respective political parties to ascertain the legality and compliance with the Law of such petitions. In fact, this is one of the two times the Supervisors pay attention to this Department; the other is at Budget time..... (keeping our salaries down to that of the other Department Deputies.)

In connection with each and every Primary, Special and General Election, this Department has to administer, instruct and distribute data to more than 500 employees (i.e. Election Inspectors, Voting Machine Custodians) in the 125 Election Districts throughout the County. Six County-wide Schools of Instruction were held for this purpose. These were held in the Auditorium of the Health and Welfare Building on September 14, 15, and 16 of 1970.

This year we were innovative in our approach to our Schools of Instruction. The use of the over-head projection techniques was designed to teach and elicit troublesome questions from the Inspectors of Election. It is our opinion that many more participants were directly involved because of this. Also, for the first time, we were able to have a voting machine available for rudimentary instruction. During this period 58 written examinations were administered to the newly appointed Inspectors.

The dates for holding the Judicial Conventions were on September 11th and 12th. The last day to fill a vacancy after declination of the Judicial Convention nomination



was September 18th.

This office publishes an annual Political Calendar. The dates of the various activities are determined by the New York State Legislature. Due to the indefinite time of enactment by the Legislature, this office publishes both a tentative and regular political calendar. Also, this office printed and distributed to all Candidates, Inspectors of Election and Party Chairmen, a pamphlet related to "Certain Sanctioned Procedures and Regulations Relating to Electioneering".

The reduction of the voting age to eighteen (Re:- Federal Voting Act) takes effect on January 4, 1971. Recent statistics would indicate an increase of 8%, 5,200 registrants and the need for extra facilities to handle such an influx. This will entail additional Central File space which is on order.

An accurate month-by-month list of registrants during Central Registration has been kept, thus using this as a reference point, we should be able to extrapolate the number of Polling Place Binders, storage and the number of new Election Districts that may be required.

The experience factor of our new quarters which are divided, are both deficient in space and operational efficiency which would not occur with a contiguous work area. The assigned space is inadequate and not in conformity with Section 30 of the New York State Election Law.
