Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 34 of the New York State Election Law, we submit the Board of Election Annual Report for the calendar year of 1972.

This has been a very active Presidential year with state-wide primaries for the Associate Judge of the Court of Appeals; Delegates and Alternates to the National Convention in the 39th Congressional District; plus the County Judge.

April 4th was the first day for circulating Designating Petitions. Dates for filing such Designating Petitions were between May 8 - 11 for the June 20th Primary Election. As a result of such action there were Primary candidates for local office.

Public and Party Office Primaries were held on Tuesday, June 20, 1972 from 12:00 noon to 9:00 P.M. A County-wide Primary was held in the Democratic and Liberal Parties in the 150th Assembly District and the Democratic, Liberal and Conservative Parties in the 149th Assembly District. The City of Jamestown held a party primary in the Democratic Party in Ward 2 Election District 3 and Ward 2 Election District 5. Also in Dunkirk Ward 1 Election District 1 and Ward 2 Election District 3.

As a result of these primary contests all 125 election districts were open on June 20th from noon to 9:00 P.M. The number of voters participating by party are as follows:

The 5,042 Primary voters represent 18.6% of those eligible registrants.

* The Conservative Party filed a petition for Opportunity to Write-In candidates for the Eighth Judicial District Convention. An earlier petition contained an insufficient number of candidates.

Although this office does not in accordance with law, have anything to do with the printing of these petitions, we are deluged with questions on proper ways to

execute them. Many of these petitions are filed with the Board of Elections. Those persons on whose behalf petitions have been filed are then notified and they can accept or decline the designation. Then it had to be established whether or not a Primary Election would occur in each of the offices, and if so, prepare for it.

The Board of Elections teams finished the Primary canvass of all voting machines by 5:00 P.M. on June 23, 1972.

The dates for holding the Judicial Conventions were on September 6th and 7th of this year. The last day to fill a vacancy after declination of the Judicial Convention nomination was September 13th.

This office frequently receives from various individuals seeking public office questions of procedure. It is our advice to these individuals to seek the aid of legal counsel in order to avoid any possible complexities.

The annual Political Calendar is published by this office. The dates of the various activities are determined by the New York State Legislature. Due to the indefinite time of enactment by the Legislature, this office frequently publishes both a tentative and regular political calendar. This was further complicated by an order by the United States District Court, Eastern District of New York, extending Central Voter Registration twice! The first extension was to September 15, 1972, then to and including Saturday, September 23rd. Previously the closing of Central Voter Registration was on September 6th, 1972.

Also, this office printed and distributed to all candidates, Inspectors of Election and Party Chairmen, a pamphlet related to "Certain Sanctioned Procedures and Regulations Relating to Electioneering".

In preparation for the Primary and General Election, a School of Instruction for Election Inspectors and Alternates, was held in the auditorium of the Hall R. Clothier Memorial Building. A total of six classes was held from September 11th through 13th. A total of 486 attended the six classes (437 Election Inspectors and 49 Alternates). A centralized School of Instructions permits the use of the overhead projector and a voting machine. Written examinations were administered to all Election Inspectors and covered many of the recent changes in the Election Law.

The General Election was held on November 7, 1972. Hours of voting were from 6:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M. The results of the Propositions and Amendments were:

The day following the November 7th General Election, this office received the election supplies which were returned from all of the 125 Election Districts, the bulk of which was received before noon. These districts utilized 150 voting machines. This represented 25 Election Districts in the County with more than one voting machine. Actually 47 Election Districts should have had more than one voting machine. It is a lack of responsiveness by local government to problems such as this that prompted the Board of Elections to present to the County Legislature per Resolution 242-72, a report concerning the feasibility of transferring all powers, duties, responsibilities..... etc., except School Board, Villages, Fire, and other Special District Elections, to the Board of Elections.

Bi-partisan teams, consisting of permanent employees began the canvass of the 150 voting machines that very afternoon. This requires a personal inspection of the sealed voting machines and verification of the results as recorded by the Election Inspectors. This physical inspection was completed by Friday at 5:00 P.M. At this time temporary help is needed annually to process the voluminous statistics in order that this office may certify the results within the mandated time.

Due to the time schedules mandated by the New York State Election Law, unusually heavy demands have been made on the County Printing Department by this office. For example, Section 376 of the Election Law mandates the printing of Registration Lists for each of the 125 Election Districts of the newly registered voters of October, 6 - 7 - 10th.

A Court of Appeals rendered a decision which prohibited, as a voting requirement, durational residence in excess of thirty days before the November 7th General Election. Therefore, this office had to prepare to register all persons who will have resided at the address from which they seek to register for at least 30 days prior to Election Day.

Insofar as Special Presidential voting is concerned, the provision permitting

a person moving into a district at least 30 days before the election to vote for President and Vice-President had to be dispensed with, since under the above mentioned ruling, these same persons were now eligible to vote for all offices.

Furthermore, the Election Law stipulates that a qualified person could move, up to and including Friday, October 27th, thus changing his address and possibly the election district. Therefore, accurate registration lists must be printed after this date. Our office is mandated per Section 376 Sub. 4, for the distribution of lists, not less than six days prior to the day of the Election, Wednesday, November 1st. Subdivision 5 of this section compels distribution of Registration Lists before the 6th day also to the Secretary of State and the Attorney General.

The printer will receive in late January, data relative to the more than 77,479 registered voters for the completion of printed Enrollments (before the first of March, 1973 pursuant to Election Law, ss 377). Our efforts to process this data is impeded by Election Law, ss 186 which states that we cannot open the Enrollment boxes until the Tuesday following the General Election and the process must be completed before the first day of February, the succeeding year. Increased use of temporary employees for ten months of the year is due to the continually expanding normal and peak work load.

Concomitant with Sec. 377, Sec. 405 mandates a Purge List begun in the second week in December and be completed in the third week in January. All permanent records and data related to the more than 77,479 enrolled voters have to be individually examined to verify if the registrant has voted at least once in a General Election during the past two years. All those that have not must be notified by mail (3,927 individuals) of the impending cancellation of their status as a registered voter unless they fill out, sign and return the re-instatement request form within three weeks of the date of the postmark on the notification. After this three week interval the newly compiled list of registered and enrolled voters is then sent to the printer, pursuant to Section 377 in conjunction with the needs of Section 191. sub. 1-a concerning Spring primaries.

Registration records under Section 381 of the Election Law are used for Village and School District Elections. Village Law, Section 4-426 (8a) and Election Law 381 states, if such village is located in a County wherein Permanent Personal Registration is required, they (Village inspectors of Elections) shall copy such names from the registration poll records.

Effective September 1, 1973 this section of Village Law, and many others appertaining to Village elections will be transferred to the Election Law. There has been considerable discussion by the Joint Legislative Committee to place Village Registration under the supervision of the Board of Elections. Presently all individuals who are registered with the Board of Elections, under P.P.R. are automatically qualified to vote in Village Elections. Conversely, an individual who registers to vote under the Village registration system is not automatically qualified to vote in a General Election. This person must personally register again under P.P.R. in order to vote in a General Election, thus many village residents are confused and disenfranchised by this dual system. This office publishes a separate Political Calendar pertaining to the Village Elections and are available for interested individuals.

At least 8 months (March 7th) before the General Election, each County, City, Village and Town Clerk, pursuant to Section 149-a, sub. 30, shall make and transmit to the Board of Elections, a certificate stating each County, City, Village, and Town officers respectively, to be voted on at the General Election, including any local proposition or question known to such officer at the time of issuance of certificate. If any officer is to be elected to fill a vacancy, the Certificate shall so state. Within the above time period the Secretary of State shall make and transmit to the Board of Elections a Certificate stating each office above County level which lawfully may be voted for at the Election.

The concentration of such information in our office generates many inquiries throughout the year concerning Election Law, Petitions, Primaries and the General Election.

Section 392 of the New York State Election Law provides for a special check of all registered voters in any or all of the election districts including those previously checked. This personal check of registrants is contingent upon the written, filed request of any one member of the Board of Elections and is conducted by legally constituted bi-partisan teams. This is especially important when one recognizes the fact that one family in five moves annually and the 18 - 30 age group is highly mobile.

The Election Commissioners Association of the State of New York, which we are active members of, have been seeking permissive legislation allowing any registrant who moves within the County, to re-register by mail. This, we feel, with proper safeguards, would be more convenient to the registrant and the Board of Elections.

Central Voter Registration in Mayville reached an intense interest due mainly to the Presidential race. From December, 1971 through April, 1972 there were 809 registrants who appeared at the Mayville office. The month of May alone yielded more than 815 registrants. This was due primarily to the May 20th deadline (E.L. ss 187, sub 2-6) for new registrants to qualify for the June 20th Primary.

Further impetus for voter registration was granted by Resolution 159-72 of the County Legislature authorizing and directing the Board of Elections to conduct such a voter registration drive throughout the County. Many of the locations were in Senior High Schools, but open to the public.

The Central Registration figure of 7,014 plus the 3 day Local Registration of 6,310 placed a total of 77,479 registrant's names on our rolls.

Section 394, states the Board of Elections, not less than 15 days nor more than 30 days (September 6th) before the first day of Local Registration (October 6th), shall conduct a Mail Check of every registered voter. This entails processing 71,447 letters to the 125 Election Districts and notifying the registrant that such communication is a routine check to ascertain whether such voter still resides at

this address. This September mailing resulted in 2,949 letters listed as undeliverable at the indicated address. Within one week (October 17th) after the conclusion of Local Registration the Board of Elections shall send similar communication (6,310) letters to every voter registered in such Local Registration period.

At this point, pursuant to the Election Law, Sec. 331, sub. 3, this Board calls upon law enforcement agencies to investigate questionable declared and actual voter residency.

Whenever such communication is returned as undeliverable, the Board of Elections forthwith shall proceed in accordance with the powers granted to it by Section 406 to determine whether such registration of the affected person shall be cancelled. This Board received 5,437 letters in 1970; 4,121 letters in 1971; and 2,949 in 1972, as undeliverable, and such legal determinations were made and verified in the 20 days prior to Election Day on November 7th. In addition, this office issued 1,006 Military and Military dependents ballots compared to 326 from the previous year. Absentee ballots issued were 2,727 versus 1,439 the year before.

Pursuant to the order of District Judge Edward Weinfeld, all Boards of Election in New York State were instructed to canvass all absentee ballots received or returned by 9:00 p.m. Election night on November 7, 1972.

In order to accomplish this, our office made arrangements with the Sectional Center of the Post Office to obtain those (6) ballots.

The accuracy and efficiency in processing this data is reflected in that only 9 Court Orders were issued. This office does assist in initiating such action as the direct result of any newly acquired information and forwarding it to the issuing Justice.

This office is in reality an office of Vital Statistics of the most current information available on a County wide basis. Each and every month pursuant to Section 397, sub. 1, this office receives from the public recording officers of the 15 Villages, 27 Towns and 2 Cities, the deaths in their respective areas in order that we may remove the deceased person from the current registration list. The number of cancelled forms due to deaths was 728; moving, etc. came to 3,677 for the year 1972. The continual updating of names and addresses as mandated by the Election Law, of Chautauqua County residents in our office results in many requests for information from the Courts, FBI, Social Security Administration, Attorneys, Private Agencies, and individuals. This office is one source of names and addresses to the

Federal and County Courts for use as potential jurors. In fact, this office provides many such services for several County Departments.

An early interest in the Fall election was generated by the Primary contests and the Voter Registration Drive conducted by the Board of Elections under Resolution 159-72. The result was a greater number of voters who cast their ballots than the two preceding Presidential Elections.

The Electors of President and Vice-President received a total County tally of 2,604,282. This office issued 3 Special Presidential ballots.

Due to the narrow margins of unofficial results for County Judge, Treasurer and Clerk, extra effort was made to certify the winners in the shortest possible time.

The day following the November 7th Election, this office received the Election supplies which were returned from all of the 125 election districts, the bulk before noon. These districts utilized 150 voting machines.

Bi-partisan teams, consisting of permanent employees began the canvass of the 150 voting machines that very afternoon. This requires a personal inspection of the sealed voting machines and verification of the results as recorded by the Election Inspectors. This physical inspection was completed by Friday at 5:00 P.M. At this time temporary help is needed annually to process the voluminous statistics in order that this office may certify the results within the mandated time.

The Town of Ellicott had the only Special Local Proposition on the ballot.

Proposition #3 - "Increasing the Number of Councilmen from 4 to 6", pursuant to Section 81, sub. 2 A of the Town Law:

Beginning the first day of Central Registration on December 7, 1972 and thereafter all persons 18 years of age or older who are otherwise qualified to vote would be eligible to register and vote at all Primary, Special and General Elections held on

or after December 7, 1972. This includes the right of Special Enrollment for the 1973 Primary Election for such new voters, pursuant to Section 187 and 388 of the Election Law.

At this point, this office feels it must comment on Resolution 242-72 and our report to the County Legislature concerning the feasibility of transferring from the Towns and Cities of Chautauqua County to the Board of Elections all powers, duties, and responsibilities....etc., except School Board, Village, Fire and other Special District Elections.

The Commissioners of the Board of Elections, feel that the existing system gives rise to fragmentation in services and the legal expertise that is needed in today's elections. Uniform services and expertise would result and minimize technical problems associated with elections.

Assuming the 29 local municipalities would donate all such voting machines, supplies, etc., as has been a past practice in other counties, the costs would be minimal to the county. In addition, the 27 Towns and 2 Cities would also be financial beneficiaries with a "Revenue Sharing" effect upon adoption of such a program.

A preliminary budget using the composite 1972 Budget for the Towns, Cities and the County Board of Elections, would appear as follows:

The 1972 County Budget indicates that for \$1 per thousand on the tax rate equals \$400,000 in the Budget. On this basis \$89,411.00 would equal 22¢ increase on the County Tax Rate. This would be a nominal cost and a maximum benefit for the services rendered to the citizens of Chautauqua County.
