AT THE REQUEST OF: County Executive Paul M. Wendel, Jr.:

WHEREAS, previous collective bargaining agreements for CSEA 6300 required the County to earmark minimally \$5,000 during each year of the agreement for reimbursement for employees for the cost of mandated trainings, required license fees, and required credentials; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 Adopted Budget for the Department of Human Resources includes an appropriation of \$5,000 to accommodate said reimbursements, and a revenue budget of \$5,000 to accommodate receiving repayment from operating departments for said reimbursements; and

WHEREAS, the 2019-2023 collective bargaining agreement for CSEA 6300 simply requires the County to reimburse employees for the cost of mandated trainings, required license fees, and required credentials; and

WHEREAS, it would be expedient for operating departments to be charged directly for said reimbursements, rather than processing costs and revenues for said reimbursements through the Department of Human Resources; and

WHEREAS, this new expedient procedure will eliminate the need for revenue and appropriation budgets within the Department of Human Resources; now therefore be it

TITLE: Authorize Sale of Tax Foreclosure Property to Home Leasing LLC

AT THE REQUEST OF: County Executive Paul J. Wendel, Jr.:

WHEREAS, the Arcade Building in the City of Jamestown located at 26-32 North Main Street (Tax Parcel # 387.48-1-19) was tax foreclosed several years ago and has been in a state of continuing deterioration for decades; and

WHEREAS, despite its current condition, the Arcade Building is an architecturally significant structure that is one of the last examples of the buildings that existed in and adjacent to Brooklyn Square at the turn of the 20th century; and

WHEREAS, Home Leasing LLC, of 700 Clinton Square, Rochester, New York, has extensive experience and success in redeveloping historic properties throughout upstate New York, and securing the necessary funding sources for such projects; and

WHEREAS, Home Leasing LLC wishes to attempt to redevelop the Arcade Building and engage in a due diligence and funding development period of up to twelve (12) months to determine if a viable project can move forward; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Home Leasing LLC for the sale of the tax foreclosed Arcade Building on the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Purchase Price. \$25,000
- 2. <u>Due Diligence and Funding Development Period</u>. Up to twelve (12) months, and as may be extended by the County Executive if deemed in the best interest of the County.
- 3. <u>Closing</u>. Within one hundred eighty (180) days after completion of the due diligence and funding development period.
- 4. Other. As negotiated by the County Executive.

TITLE: Authorize Transfer of Tax Foreclosure Properties to the Village of Brocton and Chautauqua County Land Bank Corporation (CCLBC)

BY: Administrative Services and Audit & Control Committees:

AT THE REQUEST OF: County Executive Paul J. Wendel, Jr.:

WHEREAS, the County, Village of Brocton, and CCLBC are collaborating on the remediation and redevelopment of County tax foreclosure parcels located in the Village of Brocton, consisting of an abandoned condemned building at 10 East Main Street (145.17-2-45), and the former Green Arch Restaurant at 41 West Main Street (144.20-3-24); and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brocton is purchasing the building located at 14 East Main Street, which shares a party wall with the County's tax foreclosure parcel at 10 East Main Street, and once both properties are in municipal ownership, CCLBC will utilize grant monies received from the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) to demolish both structures at a cost of approximately \$200,000; and

WHEREAS, to facilitate later redevelopment of the adjoining properties after demolition is complete at 10 East Main Street and 14 East Main Street, it is appropriate that the County convey 10 East Main Street to the Village of Brocton at no cost to help mitigate the Village's expenses in acquiring 14 East Main Street; and

WHEREAS, CCLBC is willing to acquire the former Green Arch Restaurant property located at 41 West Main Street from the County for the sum of the foreclosed back taxes on the property, being the amount of \$12,539.19, and CCLBC will then market the parcel for responsible remediation and redevelopment in order to restore the beneficial use and taxable value of the property; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the County Executive is authorized and empowered to execute all necessary documents to transfer 10 East Main Street to the Village of Brocton and 41 West Main Street to CCLBC as described above, upon such other terms and conditions negotiated by the County Executive.
