# 4/19/2020 COVID-19 Updates

## No new cases of COVID-19 in Chautauqua County today

### Chautauqua County statistics:

- 27 confirmed cases:
- 3 active cases continue to recover under orders of the Local Health Official per NYS Public Health Law;
- 21 recovered cases;
- 3 deaths:
- 39 cases under quarantine/isolation orders by the Public Health Director and being monitored. Not all of those being monitored are confirmed to have COVID-19 but have either shown symptoms, are awaiting results, or have risk factors; and
- 569 negative test results to date.

**ESSENTIAL BUSINESSES OR ENTITIES**, including any for-profit or non-profit, regardless of the nature of the service, the function they perform, or its corporate or entity structure, are not subject to the in-person restriction. *Essential Businesses must continue to comply with the guidance and directives for maintaining a clean and safe work environment issued by the Department of Health (DOH) and every business, even if essential, is strongly urged to maintain social distancing measures to the extent possible.*

#### **GOLF COURSES AND MARINAS (PER EMPIRE STATE DEVELOPMENT GUIDANCE ON EXECUTIVE ORDER 202.6)**

- However, golf courses are not essential and cannot have employees working on-premise; notwithstanding this restriction, essential services, such as groundskeeping to avoid hazardous conditions and security, provided by employees, contractors, or vendors are permitted and <u>private</u> <u>operators may permit individuals access to the property so long as there are no gatherings of any kind</u> <u>and appropriate social distancing of six feet between individuals is strictly abided</u>
- Marinas, boatyards, and recreational marine manufacturers, for ongoing marina operations and boat repair/maintenance, where such facilities adhere to strict social distancing and sanitization protocols.
  <u>Use of such sites for the purposes of personal use or operation of boats or other watercraft is permissible, provided that no establishment offer chartered watercraft services or rentals.</u> Restaurant activity at such sites are limited to take-out or delivery only.

#### **2020 CENSUS**
