



## 9/3/2020 COVID-19 Updates

## 37 New Cases of COVID-19 in Chautauqua County Today

## **Chautauqua County Statistics:**

- 166 active cases, continue to recover under orders of the Local Health Official per NYS Public Health Law including:
  - o 37 new cases today of:
    - 3 persons under the age of 18,
    - 2 male and 4 female young adults,
    - 9 males and 9 females in their 20s,
    - 2 males in their 30s.
    - 2 males and 3 females in their 40s,
    - A male in his 60s, and
    - A male and female in their 70s.
    - o 23 of the 37 new cases are SUNY Fredonia students for a total of 45 positive cases to date.
- 595 cases under quarantine/isolation orders by the Public Health Director and being monitored. Not all
  of those being monitored are confirmed to have COVID-19 but have either shown symptoms, are
  awaiting results, or have risk factors;
- 670 persons under domestic traveler quarantine for having arrived to Chautauqua County from a state listed on the New York State travel advisory;
- 5 persons hospitalized\* in Chautauqua County as of 9/2/2020
   \*number of persons in Chautauqua County hospitals diagnosed with COVID-19, regardless of residency
- To date:
  - o 303 recovered cases;
  - o 10 deaths;
  - o 479 total confirmed cases; and
  - o 35,095 negative test results.
