## 27 New Cases of COVI D-19 in Chautauqua County Reported for November 10

There was an error in the report issued yesterday, November 9 . With the 22 cases reported in yesterday's numbers, the case total should have read 1,187 rather than 1,189. Chautauqua County Offices will be closed on Wednesday, November 11 in observance of Veteran's Day. New cases will be reported on November 11 with the full report issued on Thursday, November 12.

## Chautauqua County Statistics:

- 113 active cases, continue to recover under orders of the Local Health Official per NYS Public Health Law including:
o 27 new cases were reported on November 10 including:
- 6 cases in 14701 (Jamestown)
- 6 cases in 14063 (Fredonia)
- 3 cases in 14048 (Dunkirk)
- 1 case in 14712 (Bemus Point)
- 3 cases in 14136 (Silver Creek)
- 2 cases in 14062 (Forestville)
- 1 case in 14718 (Cassadaga)
- 1 case in 14782 (Sinclairville)
- 2 cases in 14733 (Falconer)
- 2 cases in 14738 (Frewsburg)
- The Chautauqua County Health Department is currently monitoring a cluster linked to social clubs in the northern end of the County. There are currently 8 active and 0 recovered cases linked to the Beaver Club in Fredonia. In addition to the Beaver Club, there have been 20 cases linked to other social clubs; 19 cases have recovered, and 1 case is currently active.
- 21 people hospitalized* in Chautauqua County as of $11 / 08 / 2020$ (most recent data available from NYS) *number of persons in Chautauqua County hospitals diagnosed with COVID-19, regardless of residency
- To date:
o 1,086 recovered cases;
o 15 deaths; and
o 1,214 total confirmed cases.
