WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolutions 260-15, 39-16, 81-16, and 231-17, the Chautauqua County Legislature established the North Chautauqua County Water District (the "District"), to comprise an area in Chautauqua County consisting of parts of the towns of Portland, Pomfret, Sheridan and Hanover and all of the town of Dunkirk; and

WHEREAS, the District has undertaken capital improvement projects to create a regional water system for the North County, and a \$3,000,000 grant was awarded through the New York Water Infrastructure Improvement Act (WIIA) to assist the District in funding the projects; and

WHEREAS, the New York WIIA grant funds will be administered by the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation DWSRF Project Number 18321; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Chautauqua County Legislature hereby approves the acceptance of a \$3,000,000 grant to assist the District's capital projects, and the County Executive and District Chair are authorized and empowered to execute all agreements and documents necessary to secure such funds.

TITLE: Authorize Continuation of Natural Gas Lease at Chautauqua County Landfill

BY: Public Facilities and Audit & Control Committees:

AT THE REQUEST OF: County Executive Paul M. Wendel, Jr.:

WHEREAS, there are several gas wells in production at the Chautauqua County Landfill in Ellery, New York; and

WHEREAS, the existing lease will expire on July 31, 2021 and the current operator, PPP Future Development, Inc. desires to operate the wells for an additional 10 year period; and

WHEREAS, it would be advantageous to the County to continue to lease the wells; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to enter into a lease agreement with PPP Future Development, Inc., upon substantially the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Royalties. Lessee shall pay County a royalty interest of 15%.
- 2. <u>In Lieu of Option</u>. County shall be entitled to use 200,000 cubic feet of gas per year from each well in active production, or in the alternative, a payment for unused gas at the then current wellhead prices.
- 3. Other. As negotiated by the County Executive
