AT THE REQUEST OF: County Executive Paul M. Wendel, Jr.:

WHEREAS, expenses of the Chautauqua County Ethics Board are paid out of the appropriation accounts of the County Executive department; and

WHEREAS, legal services for the Ethics Board are provided by the County Law Department, but in the event the Law Department has a conflict of interest on a particular matter, the Ethics Board may retain outside counsel to advise the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Ethics Board's retention of outside counsel has caused the County Executive department's 2021 contractual expenses to exceed initial budgetary estimates, while the department's personnel expenses are now projected to have a surplus; therefore be it

TITLE: Prospective Cancellation of Uncollectible Tax Liens

BY: Administrative Services and Audit & Control Committees:

AT THE REQUEST OF: County Executive Paul M. Wendel, Jr. and Legislator Bob Scudder:

WHEREAS, the enforcing officer of any tax district may withdraw a parcel of real property tax from a pending foreclosure proceeding pursuant to Section 1138 of the Real Property Tax Law where it is inadvisable the tax district take title to a property, and

WHEREAS the governing body of a tax district pursuant to RPTL Section 1138 may find there is no practical method to enforce the collection of delinquent tax liens arising in the future against a particular parcel; and

WHEREAS, the governing body may direct the enforcing officer to issue a certificate of prospective cancellation, setting forth the relevant facts, and the parcel shall thereby become exempt from taxation until the governing body determines that the parcel should be restored to the taxable portion of the assessment roll; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That pursuant to section 1138 of the Real Property Tax Law, the Chautauqua County Legislature hereby determines there is no practical method to enforce the collection of delinquent tax liens arising in the future against the parcels listed below; and be it further

RESOLVED, That pursuant to section 1138 of the Real Property Tax Law, the Chautauqua County Legislature hereby directs the County's enforcing officer to issue a certificate of prospective cancellation against said parcels:

TITLE: Approving Labor Contract with Deputy Sheriffs' Association of Chautauqua County (DSACC)

BY: Administrative Services, Public Safety, and Audit & Control Committees:

AT THE REQUEST OF: County Executive Paul M. Wendel, Jr.:

WHEREAS, the County's negotiating team and the Deputy Sheriffs' Association of Chautauqua County (DSACC) have negotiated a tentative agreement for terms and conditions of employment from January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2.05(g) of the Chautauqua County Charter, the County Legislature must approve all labor contracts; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the County Legislature hereby approves the tentative agreement between the County and DSACC to include modifications to a step increment, modifications to longevity, modifications to employer and employee cost share of the health plan, modifications to the retiree cash-out benefit, and a three percent (3%) wage increase in 2022, a three percent (3%) wage increase in 2023, a two and one-half percent (2.5%) wage increase in 2024, and a two and one-half percent (2.5%) wage increase in 2025; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Executive is authorized and empowered to execute all necessary documents and agreements to effectuate a new labor agreement with DSACC.

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
