<u>WHEREAS, through the coordination, recommendations, and input between the</u> <u>Department of Public Facilities, Department of Planning and Development, the Chautauqua</u> <u>County Greenway Group, and Chautauqua County Parks Commission, a sound plan has been</u> <u>established to expend the \$250,000; and</u> <u>WHEREAS, out of the \$250,000 ARPA Trails funds, \$125,000 will be directed to the</u> <u>Department of Public Works and \$125,000 will be directed to Chautauqua Region Economic</u> <u>Development Corporation; and</u>

<u>WHEREAS, of the funding directed to the Department of Public Facilities,</u> approximately \$56,000 will be used for materials for in-house trail repairs such as lumber for bridges, culverts, waterway access points, and sign-in boxes; approximately \$29,000 will be used for equipment replacements for items such as chainsaws, brush saws, Jon Boat, trailer, motor, and ATV; and approximately \$40,000 will be used for improvements to County parks projects such as Luensman restrooms; and

<u>WHEREAS, of the funding directed to the Chautauqua Region Economic</u> <u>Development Corporation, approximately \$29,500 will be used for materials such as lumber</u> for kiosks, trail signs, mile markers, metal maps, and culverts; and approximately \$95,500 will <u>be used for improvements to the County's Overland trails, as well as other trail</u> <u>recommendations within the Chautauqua County Greenway Plan; therefore be it</u>

<u>RESOLVED, That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make</u> the following changes to the 2021 Adopted Budget in order to Implement the Upgrades to <u>County Trails project:</u>
