Rinse clean & separate: clear – colored beverage and food conta.iners only NO ceramics, light bulbs, oven-ware or window glass.

Plastics

Rinse and clean beverage, food, detergent. mouthwash and shampoo containers only. NO automotive fluids containers, bags or K-cups.

Metal Containers Aluminum/Tin/Steel

Rinse clean cans, foil, lids, travs, etc. NO bags or spray cans.

Scrap Metal

Aluminum, Brass, Copper, Steel, Cast Iron, Machinery, Home Appliances, Wire, Pipe, Etc.

Cardboard

Corrugated Cardboard Boxes, Paper Bags, Paper Egg Cartons, Cereal **Boxes, Toilet Paper & Paper Towel Tubes & Beverage Case Boxes. NOT ACCEPTED: Waxed, plastic** coated, plastic or foam packaging or food-contaminated materials.
