Among the personal papers of Frank B. Lamb now in Patterson Library in Westfield, New York, is a hand-written notebook in which Mr. Lamb collected for his own use the deaths and marriages before 1850 which he found in county newspapers.

All available issues of any periodical were used in sequence, thus the order in that notebook is more or less chronological. No attempt has been made here to include material other than that found in that one notebook.

In the years since Mr. Lamb made his considerable contributions to genealogical research, more issues of county newspapers have been discovered, and other gleaning has been done. In Fenton Historical Museum in Jamestown there is a valuable file of this kind of material done more recently by Mrs. Edna Ingham. In 1980, under the direction of Ms Marcia Smith, all known issues of all county newspapers have been microfilmed and are available for use by the public.
