**AT THE REQUEST OF:** County Executive Paul M. Wendel, Jr.:

WHEREAS, the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) has awarded \$193,463.00 to Chautauqua County through multiple agencies for the Gun Involved Violence Elimination (“GIVE”) initiative. The agencies involved form the GIVE Task Force to reduce gun violence, drug offenses, and other violent crimes in the primary jurisdiction of the City of Jamestown and throughout Chautauqua County; and

WHEREAS, the funded GIVE partnership consists of the City of Jamestown Police Department, and the Chautauqua County agencies of the District Attorney, Office of the Sheriff and the Probation Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jamestown Police Department has been awarded \$72,221.00 of the total GIVE funding and will sign and administer a separate contract with New York State DCJS for its portion of said funding; and

WHEREAS, Chautauqua County’s portion of the funds is \$121,242.00, and the agencies will share the remaining funds as follows: \$83,306.00 to the District Attorney’s office; \$27,436.00 to the Chautauqua County Office of the Sheriff; and \$10,500.00 to the Probation Department; and

WHEREAS, the offices of the District Attorney, Sheriff and Probation have included a portion of these grant funds in their 2022 Adopted Budgets, and will include the balance to be spent in 2023 in their proposed 2023 budgets; and

WHEREAS, this program will run from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023; and now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the County of Chautauqua accepts the grant funds and authorizes the County Executive to execute the GIVE Grant contracts with the New York State DCJS in the total amount of \$121,242.00 for the term of July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023.
