

AIRPORTS COMMISSION MEETING

7 September 2022

The meeting was held in Hangar one at KDKK and called to order at 9:24 AM by Chairman Jack Hemmer with a quorum of five Commission members present. A discussion of a recent newspaper article on accepting FAA funding preceded the meeting.

The minutes of the previous Commission meeting on 6 July 2022 were accepted as presented with no objections.

Legislative Report

Accepting grant funding for both airports anticipated and Jay Churchill was reappointed to the Commission. One more member of the Commission is still pending.

Airports Manager Report

Rebirth of the proposal to study air service at KJHW was suggested.

Reilly Enlow was introduced as the Airports Accounting Supervisor.

A Master Plan meeting is scheduled for 20 September at KJHW from 4 to 6PM.

Security procedures are under review.

NYS fire inspection completed at both airports.

Possible Fall Fest at KDKK on 22 October.

Two 2 day R/W closures at KJHW for grooving and painting planned during the next 2 weeks.

KDKK Hangar 3 new construction delayed to 2023.

Maintenance – many on-going projects at both airports.

Ellen Maternowski mentioned some lights in the parking lot at KJHW are out. She confirmed that the Air Museum will provide water sealer for the steps leading up to the observation area.

Rebranding the airports website is in the County realm.

Andrew Hartman questioned the possibility of R/W closure at KDCK during the proposed lighting upgrade; no closure planned. Obstructions still affecting approach minima at KDCK.

The meeting was adjourned by the Chairman at 10:22 AM.
