#### Glass: Jars & Bottles

Rinsed and clean clear & colored beverage and food containers only. <u>NO ceramics, light bulbs, ovenware, dishes, drinking glasses or window glass.</u>

#### **Plastics**

Rinsed and clean beverage, food, detergent, mouthwash and shampoo containers only. NO automotive fluid containers, bags of any kind or K-cups.

#### Metal Containers Aluminum/Tin/Steel

Rinse clean cans, foil, lids, trays, etc. *NO bags or spray cans*.

#### **Scrap Metal**

Aluminum, Brass, Copper, Steel, Cast Iron, Machinery, Home Appliances, Wire, Pipe, Etc.

#### Cardboard

Corrugated Cardboard Boxes, Paper Bags, Paper Egg Cartons, Cereal Boxes, Toilet Paper & Paper Towel Tubes & Beverage Case Boxes.

NO Waxed, plastic coated, plastic or foam packaging or food-contaminated materials.

#### **Paper**

Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs, Office Papers, Greeting Cards, Books and Notebooks without covers or bindings. NO padded envelopes, pet food bag or bags of shredded paper.

## **Electronics & Small Appliances**

Electronics and small appliances accepted free of charge for recycling.

#### **Examples:**

- VCRs, DVRs, DVD Players
- Cable or Satellite Receivers
- Electronic or Video Game Consoles
- Printers, printer cartridges, etc.
- TV's, Computer Monitors NO lightbulbs or fluorescent tubes
