AT THE REQUEST OF: County Executive Paul M. Wendel, Jr.:

WHEREAS, President Biden signed into law the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) on March 11, 2021, and this legislation contains a wide array of stimulus and recovery funding designed to ensure the nation's swift economic and public health recovery from COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Chautauqua County received an award of \$24,649,420 in ARPA funding, all of which is available for general county spending based on the Treasury Department's revenue loss formula and other guidance; and

WHEREAS, an ARPA Spending Plan was thoroughly reviewed by an ARPA working group, the County Executive, and the County Legislature, and was adopted pursuant to Resolution No. 202-21; and

WHEREAS, some funds allocated in the ARPA Spending Plan are no longer needed for the originally designated project(s), and are now available for other projects, and a procedure has been established for the ARPA working group to review new requests for APPA funds and to allocate the available funds; and

WHEREAS, the Jail Property Packaging System project fits within the guidelines for ARPA spending, is needed because it separates and seals inmate's property so Jail staff does not come in contact, and budget amendments are necessary to authorize spending for the project; now therefore be it

TITLE: Amend Emergency Services 2024 Budget – 2024 Eclipse Preparedness

AT THE REQUEST OF: County Executive Paul M. Wendel, Jr.:

WHEREAS, the Office of Emergency Services is planning for the operations and safety for Chautauqua County for the upcoming April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024 Total Solar Eclipse; and

WHEREAS, this event is expected to have a large impact on Chautauqua County and additional steps are being taken to help ensure safety and security for all; and

WHEREAS, additional DisasterLAN Computer Software (DLAN), estimated to cost \$12,000, is needed to assist in the emergency planning and execution of this event; and

WHEREAS, additional EMS and mass casualty medical supplies, estimated to cost \$25,000, are needed to stage in areas around the county to assist in the event of a large scale EMS response; and

WHEREAS, a First Net Compact Rapid Deployable (CRD, Cell-on-wheels), estimated to cost \$98,000, is needed to facilitate back-up communications and 911 redundancy, where said device will help to ensure communications during this event and beyond; and

WHEREAS, additional traffic supplies including 2 (Two) Variable Message Sign (VMS) Trailers, 2 (Two) vehicle mounted Variable Message Sign Boards and 30 minute traffic flares are needed and are estimated to cost \$59,350, and

WHEREAS, these expenditures are not included in the 2024 Adopted Budget; now therefore be it
