TITLE: Authorize Public Hearing to Enter into Solar Lease Agreement at the Chautauqua

Dunkirk Airport (DKK) with New York State Energy Research and Development

Authority (NYSERDA)

AT THE REQUEST OF: County Executive Paul M. Wendel, Jr.:

WHEREAS, the County owns and operates the Chautauqua County Dunkirk Airport in the Town of Sheridan in a manner that provides services and facilities on a non-exclusive basis for the general use of the public and to enhance current and future economic development in the County; and

WHEREAS, NYSERDA, for the sole purpose of developing the Premises for the construction, installation, use, maintenance and operation of solar generating equipment and related appurtenances, improvements, facilities and equipment (collectively, the "Facilities") by the winner of a competitive bid process to be implemented pursuant to New York State Energy Research and Development Authority's ("NYSERDA") Build Ready Program (Title 9-B of Article 8 of the NYS Public Authorities Law); and

WHEREAS, the Airport Commission has considered and recommends leasing property to NYSERDA for the solar purpose of revenue generation and solar development; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing pursuant to Article 14 of the General Municipal Law is required prior to approval of a lease of airport facilities; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That, pursuant to General Municipal Law, a public hearing on the proposed lease agreement of the Chautauqua County Dunkirk Airport with NYSERDA to include substantially the following terms and conditions, shall be held at 6:35 p.m. during the meeting of the Chautauqua County Legislature to occur on August 28, 2024, in the Legislative Chambers, Gerace Office Building, Mayville, New York 14757:

- 1. <u>Term</u>. Ten year option period
- 2. Premises. 71+/- acres of property at the Chautauqua County Dunkirk Airport (DKK)
- 3. Payment. Mutually-agreed rate equivalent to Full Market Value
- 4. Other. As negotiated by the County Executive.

; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Legislature is authorized and directed to publish notice of this hearing at least ten (10) days prior thereto in the official newspapers of the County of Chautauqua.

WHEREAS, funding for Mobility Management is shared at the rate of 80% Federal, I0% State, and 10% local dollars and revenues and expenditures for this program were included in the current budget and will be included in all future budgets; and

WHEREAS, funding for purchase support vehicle is shared at the rate of 80% Federal, 10% State, and 10% local dollars; and

WHEREAS, funding for New Other Equipment (cameras for the buses) is shared at the rate of 80% Federal, 10% State, and 10% local dollars; and

WHEREAS, the appropriate funding has been included in the 2024 Adopted Budget so no budget amendment is needed; now therefore be it
