WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1.05 of the Chautauqua County Charter directed that “no later than July 1, 2004 and every ten (10) years thereafter, a Charter and Administrative Code Review Commission shall be established to review and make recommendations to the County Executive and Legislature on amendments, additions or revisions to the County Charter and Administrative Code. The Commission shall consist of not more than ten (10) citizens of Chautauqua County with five (5) of the said members appointed by the County Executive and the remaining five (5) to be appointed by the Legislature” and

WHEREAS, the report of such Commission shall be presented to the Executive and the Legislature not later than July 1, 2025; now therefore be it
