- Solar MOU DKK Approved by Legislators
  - NYSERDA -
    - This will utilize approximately 70 acres of land. Land lease to the airport at FMV.
    - NYSERDA will maintain the land and the panels.
    - Discussion of the energy storage and battery
      - Power will go to the battery first, then goes to the grid as needed.
      - Discussion of storing the power and selling it at peak times.
      - Shannon Fischer, showed the group on a map of the Dunkirk Airport where these Solar panels will be located. Storage of the energy will be off the airport property.
  - Discussion of having the MOU approved is the first step. Second step will be a study done by NYSERDA, to see if project is feasible.
