The parking lot on Eggleston Hill Rd is awaiting the ditching and pipe by the Town of North Harmony. The fiber optic cable work there has been completed.

Erlandson Park water test passed. The drinking fountain is not working properly and is being checked. The Kimball Stand lean-to squatters have been removed.

Harris Hollow bridge is completed and graded. It will open next week for hiking etc.

The North Hill property trash has been removed and rocks have been placed to block the driveway. Jamie explained he will now be our Parks Dept. contact and in charge of day-to-day operations(other than Pats work), scheduling, and easements.

Twan sent an update on the waterway work. They are working on a 20-mile section of Cassadaga creek- Kabob to Falconer Ellicott launch.

Jacob stated the new Trail mapping app - Avenza is up and running- all trails in the county are accessible on it. He has placards to place on/in the sign-in boxes with the QR code for easy access. Work will begin Brokenstraw to Titus Rd next week. Phase 4 will be completed soon.

Tom gave a brief history and highlights of the 72-acre park Erlandson Park.
