DESCRIPTION OF POSITION: The Chautauqua County Department of Health and Human Services is urgently seeking qualified applicants to help with the COVID pandemic in Mayville, NY. A Public Health Sanitarian performs a variety of professional activities that may include the investigation and inspection of the non-engineering aspects of environmental health control. A Sanitarian investigates nuisance conditions, interprets laboratory reports, provides training, assistance and supervision of subordinate personnel, prepares reports and recommendations and testifies at enforcement proceedings. The work is performed under supervision of a higher level Sanitarian or Director of Environmental Health Services. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- Inspects food service establishments, private water supplies, private sewage disposal systems, bathing beaches and swimming pools, facilities for refuse disposal, x-ray installations, temporary and/or permanent residences and farm labor camps;
- Conducts air pollution studies and soil percolation tests;
- Collects water, food and other samples for laboratory examination and may perform laboratory analysis as assigned;
- Prepares reports on inspections and investigations;
- Supervises Public Health Sanitarian Trainees, Public Health Technicians and Aides.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS Good knowledge of environmental health practices; ability to supervise the work of others; ability to prepare and deliver effective talks and secure the interest and cooperation of civic groups and officials; ability to train others in environmental health work; ability to develop good working relationships; good professional judgment; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a Bachelor's degree including a minimum of 30 credit hours in the natural sciences, of which not more than twelve (12) credit hours may be in the applied sciences, and one (1) year of experience in a related field.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS - The following trainings and certifications must be completed within two (2) years of permanent appointment and maintained during service in this classification:

- 1) Basic Environmental Health course offered by the New York State Department of Health; AND
- 2) Food Safety Inspection Officer I Certification issued by the NYS Bureau of Community Environmental Health and Food Protection (BCEHFP).

NOTE: These minimum qualifications are based upon the minimum set by Section 11.111 of the Sanitary Code per 2008 revisions and include additional experience requirements required by Chautauqua County.
