<div>Shall the following resolution be adopted?</div> <div>RESOLVED, that the annual budget of the Clymer Central School District, Chautauqua County, New York (the “District”) for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2025 and ending June 30, 2026, as presented by the Board of Education, is hereby approved and adopted and the required funds therefore are hereby appropriated and the necessary real property taxes shall be raised by taxation on the taxable property of the District to be levied and collected as required by law. 2025-2026 Budget amount is \$12,333,908</div>

<div>Proposition No. 2</div> <div>Establishment of a Transportation Reserve Fund for the Acquisition of School Buses and Similar Vehicles (and Related Equipment)</div>		<div>Proposition No. 3</div> <div>Purchase of School Buses for the Transportation Program of the District</div>	
<div>Shall the following resolution be adopted?</div> <div>RESOLVED, that the Board of Education (the “Board”) of the Clymer Central School District, Chautauqua County, New York (the “District”) is hereby authorized to establish a new capital reserve fund (the “Fund”) for the acquisition of various school buses, school bus-type vans/minivans, and similar vehicles (and related equipment) for use in the transportation program of the District, all pursuant to Section 3651 of the Education Law of the State of New York; that the Fund shall be known as the “Transportation Reserve Fund, 2025”; that the ultimate amount of the Fund shall be not greater than \$10,000,000 (plus interest earned thereon); that the probable term of the Fund shall be not longer than ten (10) years; and that the permissible sources from which the Board is authorized to appropriate monies to the Fund from time to time shall be (A) amounts applied thereto from budgetary appropriations of the District; (B) unappropriated/unrestricted fund balance of the District as may be directed by the Board; (C) to the extent specifically directed by the Board, State aid received as reimbursement for transportation-related expenditures by the District (whether or not such expenditures were financed in whole or in part from the Fund); (D) proceeds from the sale of real or personal property owned by the District, if permitted by law and if directed by the Board; (E) one or more other reserve funds of the District; and/or (F) such other sources as the Board or the voters of the District may direct from time to time, all as may be permitted by law.</div>		<div>Shall the following resolution be adopted?</div> <div>RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Clymer Central School District (the “District”) is hereby authorized to purchase school buses and similar vehicles and related equipment and supplies at a maximum estimated cost of \$169,065 for use in the transportation program of the District, utilizing \$169,065 from funds currently on hand in the District’s “School Bus Reserve Fund 2021” that was established by the voters of the District in May of 2021.</div>
