<p><b>Proposition #3 - 2022 Capital Project</b> (Vote YES or NO)</p> <p style="text-align: center; font-size: 48px; opacity: 0.5;">SAMPLE</p> <p>Shall the following resolution be adopted to wit: RESOLVED, that the Board of Education (the "Board") of the Forestville Central School District (the "District") is hereby authorized to undertake a capital improvement project consisting of (i) at the to undertake a capital improvement project consisting of alterations, renovations and improvements to the District's school building and associated facilities, site improvements for various school purposes and other appurtenant and related improvements, environmental controls, and improvements and renovations to the heating and ventilation systems, roof replacement, interior renovations, and the acquisition and installation in and around the foregoing improvements of original furnishings, equipment, machinery, apparatus, technology and energy savings improvements through guaranteed applicable energy incentives, and other services incidental thereto (collectively, the "Project") and (ii) to expend \$750,000 from the District's existing General Capital Reserve Fund, the total estimated maximum cost of the Project to not to exceed \$8,475,000, with such cost being raised by the expenditure of such \$750,000 from the General Capital Reserve Fund, with the balance thereof, not to exceed \$7,725,000, being raised by a tax upon the taxable property of the District to be levied and collected in annual installments as provided in Section 416 of the Education Law, with such tax to be offset by State aid available therefore, and in anticipation of such tax, by obligations of the District as may be necessary.
