LOCAL LAW NO. 2-1954 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

A Local Law of the County of Chautauqua to Provide for the Removal of a Certain Highway in the Town of Ellery, Chautauqua County from the Classification of Controlled Access Highway

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chautauqua as follows:

Section 1. That notwithstanding any provision to the contrary in any conveyance or in the Highway Law, or any rule or regulation made by the Superintendent of Public Works, or any resolution of this Board of Supervisors, that portion of State highway No. 5245 (Route 17) commencing at Shore Acres in the Town of Ellery, Chautauqua County and running thence northerly to the intersection of the old road for a distance of approximately 3.4 miles is removed from the classification of controlled access highways.

Section 2. That the property owners owning property abutting on said highway or their grantees, shall have full access to said highway in the same way and to the same extent as on a full access highway.

Section 3. That the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors of Chautauqua County is authorized to execute for Chautauqua County any and all papers necessary to carry out the foregoing purpose, including deeds or conveyances to the abutting property owners giving them full access to said highway.

Section 4. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
